

Up to now, no residents in Thailand have been reported to have contact ed the Middle East respiratory syndrome coronavirus (MERS-CoV), spreading in South Korea. The Ministry of Public Health has taken precautionary steps to prevent the spread of the disease. One of the precautionary efforts includes setting up temperature monitoring stations at six international airports to monitor the possible entry of MERS-CoV disease among airline passengers. An advisory for tourists travelling to South Korea and Thais who work in Middle East or join pilgrimages to Saudi Arabia has also been given. ( 10/6/2015)
