

On November 27, at the opening of the inaugural Mekong-ROK Commemorative Summit, in Busan, South Korea, Prime Minister General Prayut Chan-o-cha delivered a keynote address and shared his vision on the laying out of the third action plan, which will be implemented in 2021, based on the 3Ps (People, Prosperity, Peace) principle. They include the following: 1) People for Inclusive Society: To increase people-to-people exchanges, and to promote mutual understanding and people-centered cooperation, among others; 2) Prosperity by Sharing Experience: To work together, and to promote Connecting the Connectivity; 3) Peace for Sustainable Development: The PM endorsed fostering cooperation to cope with non-traditional security challenges.
