

The Royal Thai Police have released guidance on how to conduct ourselves during the Songkran festival in 2020 to reduce the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). The public has been urged not to organize activities at any level. A water celebration ban, not returning to hometowns, not pouring water to pay respects to the elderly, suspending all religious activities at temples, and avoiding activities where crowds might gather. Violators of the prohibition on social gatherings are liable to a fine of up to 40,000 baht and/or a two-year jail term. (12/4/2020)
